TIME AND PLACE TO RECEIVE BIDS: Bids will be received in the Office of Director of Building Operations, MCCSC Service Center, 560 East Miller Drive, Bloomington, Indiana 47401 until 1:00 P.M., local time on Tuesday, July 10, 2018. The Bids shall be noted for date and time upon receipt. Bids will be publicly opened immediately after the deadline, at 1:00 P.M. on July 10, 2018 in the MCCSC Service Center. Bids received after that time will be returned unopened. Bids received by facsimile or electronic mail will not be accepted.

DESCRIPTION: Project includes renovation of the existing entrances at the following elementary schools: Arlington, Childs, Clear Creek, Marlin, Summit, Unionville and University, and card access installations on existing entrances at: Academy of Science and Entrepreneurship, Broadview Learning Center, Childs Preschool, Extended Resource Center, Extended Services, Grandview Elementary, Lakeview Elementary, Rogers Elementary, Templeton Elementary and Transportation including architectural, mechanical and electrical as shown on the Contract Documents prepared by Springpoint Architects, P.C. and their consultants, dated June 14, 2018.

TYPE OF BID: Stipulated Sum Bids will be received for the Work, which includes selective demolition, general construction, heating, ventilation, air conditioning, plumbing, electrical, site and all related and miscellaneous work, which will be awarded under a single contract. BID BOND: Each Bid shall be accompanied by a Certified Check, a Cashier's Check or a Bid Bond (A310) in the amount of Ten Percent (10%) of the total bid made payable to the Monroe County Community School Corporation. Should a successful Bidder withdraw his bid, or fail to execute a satisfactory Contract within ten (10) days after notice of acceptance of his bid, the Owner may declare the Bid Security forfeited as liquidated damages, not as penalty.

BID HOLDING PERIOD: A Bid may not be modified, withdrawn or canceled by the Bidder for Sixty (60) days following the time and date designated for the receipt of Bids.

PERFORMANCE BOND AND LABOR AND MATERIAL PAYMENT BOND: Within five (5) days of being awarded the Bid and prior to execution of the contract, the successful Bidder shall furnish a Performance and Labor and Materials Payment Bond in an amount equal to one hundred-ten percent (110%) of the total bid amount with an approved surety company. Bonds shall remain in full force and effect for a period of 12 months after final completion of the contract.

RIGHT TO REJECT BID PROPOSALS: The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any and all Bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. All Bids may be held for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days before awarding Contracts.
