Indiana University is issuing a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to engineers/contractors to propose measures to automate the chilled water production and distribution systems on the IU Bloomington campus. The objective of the project is to improve the overall energy performance of the system and lower the cost of operation while maintaining Indiana University design standards.

Proposals shall be clearly labeled: "Qualifications for Chilled Water Production and Distribution Automation - Indiana University Bloomington Campus – IU 20139129."

This is the first of a two-phase selection procedure intended to pre-qualify firms capable of providing the necessary services. Firms chosen in the Phase 1 pre-qualification process will be asked to submit a Phase 2 Technical Proposal based on a Request for Proposals (RFP) issued to them by IU.
