
INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that the City of Muncie herein referred to as the Owner, will receive sealed bids for the Madison Street Resurfacing Improvements project resurfacing Madison Street and improvements of sidewalk and curbs between Kirby Street and Wysor Street, located in the City of Muncie, Delaware County, Indiana.

Sealed bids are invited and may be delivered or forwarded by mail or other courier services addressed to the **Muncie City Clerk's Office, 300 N. High Street, Muncie, Indiana 47305 until 9:00am (local time) on October 25, 2017.** Bids received after such hour will be returned unopened. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at the Board of Works meeting on the first floor of City Hall that morning. Bids will then be taken under advisement for review by the owner and architect/engineer.

The contract will consist of the following:

Resurfacing of Madison Street beginning at the intersection of Kirby Street and continuing approximately 0.6 miles along Madison Street to the intersection of Wysor Street. This also includes reconstruction of the sidewalk & curbs at various locations along the same length of Madison St. and incidentals including milling/resurfacing of the pavement, new pavement markings, signal detection loop replacement, curb and sidewalk replacement, mulched seeding, drive construction and maintenance of traffic. Minor drainage improvements are included.

Construction Plans and a Project Manual that includes Bidding Documents, Contract Documents, Bonding Information, General and Supplementary Conditions, Special Provisions, and Technical Specifications for the project are on file and may be examined at the following locations.

Complete sets of Construction Plans and the Project Manual can be obtained from Eastern Engineering Supply, 2810 N. Wheeling Ave., Muncie, IN 47403, www.easternengineering.com. A non-refundable fee of \$100 for each printable set (shipping and handling not included) and a non-refundable fee of \$60 for each digital set. Fees are to be *submitted to Eastern Engineering Supply* and shall be made payable to **HWC Engineering**. Any shipping and handling charges shall be made payable to Eastern Engineering Supply. All Bidder submitting a sealed Bid shall obtain the Bidding Documents from Eastern Engineering Supply. Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of record at Eastern Engineering. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive.

The work to be performed and the bid to be submitted shall include sufficient and proper sums for all general construction, mechanical installation, labor, materials, permits, licenses, insurance, and so forth incidental to and required for the construction of the facilities.

Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the title of the Project and the name and address of Bidder. All bids must be submitted on the bid forms as identified in the Project Manual.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the Owner, in a sum of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, which check or bond will be held by the Owner as evidence that the bidder will, if awarded the contract, enter into the same with the Owner upon notification from him to do so within ten (10) days of said notification.

Approved performance and payment bonds guaranteeing faithful and proper performance of the work and materials, to be executed by an acceptable surety company, will be required of the Contractor at the time he executes his contract. The bond will be in the amount of 100% of the Contract Price and must be in full force and effect throughout the term of the Construction Contract plus a period of at least twelve (12) months from the date of substantial completion.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid, or all bids, or to accept any bid or bids, or to make such combination of bids as may seem desirable, and to waive any and all informalities in bidding. Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of bids or authorized postponement thereof. Any bid received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least sixty (60) days.

A conditional or qualified Bid will not be accepted. Award will be made to the low, responsive, responsible bidder. All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the projects shall apply to the Projects throughout.

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on bid forms included in the Project Manual. Bids shall include all information requested by Indiana Form 96 (Revised 2013) included with the Project Manual. Under Section III of Form 96, the Bidder shall submit a financial statement. A copy of the proposed Financial Statement to be submitted with the bid is included in the bid documents section of the Project Manual. The Owner may make such investigations as deemed necessary to determine the ability of the Bidder to perform the work and the Bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such Bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such Bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the work contemplated therein.

Each Bidder is responsible for inspecting the Project site(s) and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the Construction Plans and Project Manual. The failure or omission of any Bidder to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any Bidder from any obligation with respect to its Bid.
