Bids shall be properly and completely executed in accordance with the Instructions and Supplementary Instructions to Bidders 004100 and shall be submitted on the bid form provided in these specifications, Section 003100 and 003125. Three copies of the bids shall be submitted.

The bid shall also be accompanied by a bid bond, Section 003300, in the amount of 10 percent of the bid.

Other required documents to be submitted with the bid include the following:

Prime Contractor is to include a contingency allowance in their bid. Allowance is to be used for changes in scope resulting from unforeseen conditions at the site. Allowance can only be used with written approval by Architect and Owner. Any unused allowance must be returned to the Owner.
