

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
RICHMOND INDIANA

Notice is hereby given that the City of Richmond, Indiana will receive sealed bids for the above described "Project/Work" at the City of Richmond, Department of Purchasing, 50 North 5th Street, Richmond, IN 47374 no later than 5:00 PM on the 10th day of September 2015 and commencing as soon as practicable thereafter on the same date such bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Richmond Municipal Building, Council Chambers located at 50 North 5th Street, Richmond, IN 47374. No late bids will be accepted.

All proposals shall be properly and completely executed as prescribed by the State Board of Accounts of the State of Indiana. All proposals submitted shall be accompanied by an acceptable Bidder's Bond, Certified Check or Cashier's Check made payable to the City of Richmond, Indiana in the amount of 5% of the total bid price. If the bidder is from out-of-state, the Bidder's Bond must be secured by a Surety who is admitted to do business in Indiana. The successful bidder will be required to submit a Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid price and 100% Labor and Materials Payment Bond prior to commencing work. Checks of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned on award of proposals.

Specifications and bid forms may only be obtained from the online plan room <distribution.easternengineering.com>. All proposals should be placed in a sealed envelope marked "Confidential-Bid Proposal" on outside of envelope.

The Work consists of, but is not necessarily limited to the following:

Removal of unsafe structure(s) in Richmond, IN

This Work will be funded by the Blight Elimination Program funds via the US Treasury awarded to the City of Richmond. Good faith efforts will be made and reasonable steps taken to include Minority Business Enterprise (MBE), Disabled Business Enterprise (DBE), Women Business Enterprise (WBE), Veteran Owned Small Business (VOSB) and Service Disabled Veterans Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) for this contract. Bidder will be required to comply with all applicable Equal Employment Opportunity laws and regulations, including Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1983.

A mandatory pre-bid conference for discussion of the Work, the bidding requirements will be held on August 28, 2015 at 10:00am in the City Council Chambers, 50 North 5th Street, Richmond, IN 47374. All prospective Bidders must attend the pre-bid conference as individual meetings with contractors will not occur.
