











# OVERALL FLOOR PLAN AUDITORIUM






# OVERALL FLOOR PLAN – CENTRAL PLANT







#### PART 1 - GENERAL

#### 1.01 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and General Provisions of the Sub Contract, including amended General Conditions and other Division 1 Specification Sections, apply to Work of this Section.

#### 1.02 SUMMARY

- A. The intent of this Section is to indicate the Work required by the Subcontractors and to provide information regarding the duties, responsibilities, and cooperation required by the Contractors, with similar requirements for the subcontractors and suppliers.
- B. Owners right to maintain current operations
- C. Occupancy requirements
- D. Work by Owner
- E. Permits, fees, and notices
- F. Labor and materials
- G. Verifications of existing dimensions

#### 1.03 WORK UNDER SEPARATE CONTRACTS

# **E-Verify Compliance –**

Contractor shall enroll in and verify the work eligibility status
of all newly hired employees of Contractor through the EVerify Program.

## Safe Vendor –

 Contractor is responsible for the cost of this background check. This should meet with the Owner's approval prior to the employee starting work on the project.



 Written Drug Testing Plan that covers all employees of the bidder who will perform work on the public work project
