Summary of Work:

The project will have multiple Prime Contracts and will be coordinated by the Grand Wayne Convention Center. The scope of work will include a roof recover of approximately 125,000 square feet of existing roof area. Portions of the roof will receive a solar panel system. Roof recover scope to include repairs as required and all other Work as indicated in the Contract Documents. All work to provide for a complete installation and be carried out a timely manner according to the Contract Documents.

Each Bid proposal shall include labor, material and services necessary to complete the project in strict accordance with the drawings and specifications as prepared and on file in the office of the Owner, Grand Wayne Convention Center 120 W. Jefferson Blvd. Fort Wayne, IN 46802.

Bids shall be received for the following:

Multiple Contract Project consisting of the following prime contracts:

Bid Package 07 – PVC Roofing and Roofing Specialties Bid Package 26 – Photovoltaic Panels

The Bids shall be <u>lump sum</u> and shall be received for Multiple Prime Contracts. The Bid opening will be public. Bids shall be properly and completely executed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and shall be submitted on the Supplementary Bid Form. (See Instructions to Bidders, Spec Section 00 21 13.)

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, a cashier's check, or a bid bond executed by a surety company which is authorized to do business in the State of Indiana, made payable to the Grand Wayne Convention Center and in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the bid. In the event a bidder withdraws its bid or fails to execute a satisfactory contract within ten (10) days after the contract is awarded to such bidder by the Owner, the Owner may declare the certified check, cashier's check or bid bond forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages.

Performance and Labor and Material Payment Bonds in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount shall be required to be provided by the successful bidder to the Owner or its assignee no later than ten (10) days after the execution of such contract. Such bonds shall remain in full force and effect for a period of twelve (12) months after the date of Substantial Completion. All bids shall be itemized and all signatures must include the corporate position of the signer, and shall be properly notarized.

Pre-Bid Meeting:

A Pre-Bid meeting will be held on <u>Friday January 31st</u>, 2025, at 10:00am local time, at Grand Wayne Convention Center, located at 120 W. Jefferson Blvd. Fort Wayne, IN 46802, located in the Calhoun CD conference room. Any Pre-Bid addenda will be issued after the Pre-Bid Meeting but no later than two working days before the due date on the Bid Form. Indiana State Gross Retail and Use Tax is not to be included in the Bid Price, as Grand Wayne Convention Center is tax exempt. The provision shall apply both to transactions between Grand Wayne Convention Center and the Unified Contractor and any subcontractors and to transactions between the material to the Unified Contractor.

Builders Risk Insurance Requirements

The Contractor shall maintain such insurance as will protect him/her from claims under Workmen's Compensation Acts, other employee benefit acts, claims for damages because of bodily injury including death to his/her employees and all others, and claims for damage to property any of all which may arise both out of and during operations under this Contract, whether such operations be by himself/herself or by any Subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them, this insurance shall be written for not less than the limits of liability as specified as follows:

Bids shall not be modified, withdrawn or canceled, without the Owner's written consent, for a period of ninety (90) calendar days commencing from the day Bids are received.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish insurance covering Workmen's Compensation, Public Liability and Property Damage and any other which may be required, before the contract can be signed and issued. The Owner reserves the right to waive any and all formalities and informalities or to reject any and all Bids. The Owner shall accept Bids which, in his judgement, are in his own best interests. Bids received after the time set to receive Bids shall be returned unopened.

Certificates of such insurance shall be filed with the Owner and the Architect. The Contractor also shall maintain insurance required under any other employee benefits acts in force at the place of building. Property damage liability including claims due to automobiles shall be issued with bodily injury claims under general liability policy. All liability insurance required herein shall be under comprehensive general and automobile bodily injury and property damage form policy. Certificates of such aforementioned insurance shall be filed with the Owner and the Architect. Certificates shall name the Grand Wayne Convention Center, its Trustees, Officers, Employees and Agents, Design Collaborative Architects & Engineers, and its employees as additional insured parties.
