INVITATION TO BIDDERS

The Owner will receive bids for the Construction of Project, and all related accessories, in Elwood, Indiana all in accordance with the Construction Drawings and Specifications. **Bids will be received until 5:45 PM local time, on Monday October 5, 2026, in the City Municipal Building at the Clerk-Treasurer's Office, 1505 South B Street, Elwood, Indiana 46036.** Bids received after that time will be returned unopened. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 6:00 PM local time in the City Municipal Building Council Chambers at the same address. Prior to the bid date, Bids shall be delivered to: City of Elwood Clerk Treasurer, 1505 South B Street, Elwood, Indiana 46036. The bid envelope must be sealed and state "BID – CSO 1 WWTP Improvements".

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 PM local time on Monday September 21, 2026, at the Elwood WWTP, 900 South J Street, Elwood, Indiana 46036.

The work shall consist of construction of a new 20 MGD wet weather lift station, with a mechanical fine screen and washer-compactor for the screenings, a 20 MGD Storm King Swirl Concentrator with liquid sodium hypochlorite for disinfection and sodium bi-sulfate de-chlorination, related tank dewatering and solids treatment systems, flow monitoring and controls and a new non-potable process water storage and booster pump system, along with building modifications and additions to existing buildings according to the Construction Documents for the City of Elwood Wastewater Treatment Plant CSO 1 Improvements as prepared by **Whitaker Engineering, Neo Engineers, and Cornerstone Engineering.**

The Proposal must be made on the forms provided in the Contract Documents. The Bidder must supply all the information required by the bid proposal form. Each bid shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check, drawn on an acceptable bank, or an acceptable bidder's bond, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid, payable to the City of Elwood, Indiana. The bidder to whom a contract for work is awarded will be required to furnish a Performance, Maintenance and Payment Bond executed on the specified forms and acceptable to the Owner, in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract.

Partial payment will be made monthly. The Contractor and all subcontractors will be required to comply with required Federal and State labor regulations including Equal Employment Opportunity, Non-segregated Facilities, Davis Bacon Wage Rates, and Affirmative Action requirements.

This project requires compliance with the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) which requires all the iron and steel products, manufactured products, and construction materials, permanently incorporated in the project be produced in the United States.

Bids may be held by the Owner for a period of not to exceed ninety (90) days from the date of the opening of the bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids, the investigation of the qualifications of bidders, and finalizing project funding, prior to awarding of the Contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive technicalities.
