Item: Description:

Bid Information

Bids may be received in the Wells County Area Plan Office located at 223 W Washington Street, Room 211, Bluffton, IN 46714 at any time before 3:00 PM on the day of the bid opening. Bids may be received from 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM in the multi-Purpose Room located at 223 W Washington Street, Room 105, Bluffton, IN 46714.

Bid Questions

1-01 Is copper press allowable in lieu of copper solder for domestic water?

<u>Answer:</u> Yes, press for above-ground domestic water is allowable as follows: "Viega Propress" wrought copper fittings with EPDM-rubber O-ring seal in each end.

1-02 Are press fittings allowable for gas and compressed air piping?

Answer: For type L copper for above-ground compressed air piping, press is allowable as follows: "Viega Propress" wrought copper fittings with EPDM-rubber O-ring seal in each end for oil-free compressed air piping. Ensure fittings are rated for compressed air service. However,

Press is not allowable for gas piping; gas piping to be schedule 40 black steel with threaded or welded fittings per specifications.

1-03 *Is a performance and payment bond required?*

Answer: No

1-04 Are liquidated damages applied to this project? If so, what is the dollar amount?

Answer: Yes. It will be \$2,000 per day.

1-05 What is the time frame for this project? Is there a schedule for this project?

1-11 Are sleeve seal systems required on all penetrations through the slab-on-grade?

Answer: Yes. See notes #9 & 10 under EXECUTION on Sheet P-001.

1-12 Will a door hardware schedule be forthcoming soon?

Answer: Refer to Sheet A-601

1-13 Do I provide the door hardware or will CIH be providing door hardware for the four aluminum entrances?

Answer: The aluminum door supplier will provide the hardware for the aluminum entrances.

1-14 *Will the wood doors be pre-glazed?*

Answer: Yes.

1-15 Will the HM doors be pre-glazed?

Answer: No.

1-16 The specs are attached for the non-clog lift station package and the associated drawings. The attached drawing does match up to the specifications, so I wanted to confirm if you prefer we proceed per the specs or the attached drawing?

Answer: Please provide per the specifications.

1-17 There are Grinder lift station specs included in the project (Section 333216), but I don't see any grinder packages on the drawings. Can you please advise if there are any grinder packages required and provide a drawing and quantity so we can quote?

Answer: Please provide per the specifications. An add alternate may be provided if deemed necessary.

1-18 Is Seismic requires for this project? (Class B and important factor of 1, by code, No seismic required.)

Answer: This is not a high seismic area, correct.
