



## **ADDENDUM NO. 2**

June 7, 2024

The following items are revisions, clarifications and additions to the original drawings and project manual for the above referenced project.

### **GENERAL**

1. AD-01 issued in error. This item was mistakenly issued as an addendum when it was simply intended as a Notice To Bidders. Please acknowledge receipt of Pre-Bid Meeting Notification as Addendum No. 1 on your Bid Form.

#### **DRAWINGS**

#### Sheet A.300 CAMPUS ROOF REPLACEMENT PLAN & DETAILS

- 1. Types of valleys on the roof project (see keynotes, updated on the plan) Clarification:
  - a. Woven Valleys: are not intended anywhere on this project.
  - b. Base Bid Roof Areas (main hospital building) there are both open (metal-lined) and closed cut valleys.
    - 1) <u>Closed-Cut Valleys</u>: Short run valleys (including penthouses) are intended to be of this type.
    - 2) Open (metal-lined) Valleys: Longer run valleys are intended to be of this type.
  - c. Alternate Bid Roof Areas (out buildings) are intended to have Closed-Cut Valleys (where they exist).
- 2. Flashing of Existing Mechanical Curbs Clarification:
  - a. Provide and install new prefinished metal flanged crickets on the uphill side of all existing mechanical curbs.
  - b. Provide step flashing on all sloped sides of existing mechanical curbs.
  - c. Provide apron flashing lapped over shingles on the downhill side of all existing mechanical curbs.
  - d. Provide perimeter prefinished metal counterflashing at perimeter of all existing mechanical curbs to completely conceal and protect curbs from inclement weather.
  - e. Seal all new fasteners and all existing fasteners at existing curbs, exhaust fans, and curb adapters.
  - f. Replace detail 3/A.300 in its entirety as indicated on the plan.

## PRE-BID MEETING NOTES

Meeting Date: June 6, 2024

Attendance: See attached Pre-Bid Attendance sheet

Lucas Konger conducted the Pre-Bid Meeting which convened at 1:30 p.m. in the meeting room of the Maintenance Building immediately adjacent to the office of Mr. Aaron Eddy, Director of Facilities Maintenance for Paulding County Hospital.

- 1. LK handed out a Pre-Bid Meeting Agenda to attendees (see attached).
- 2. Attendees verbally introduced themselves in order around the room.
- 3. A Pre-Bid Attendance Sheet was passed around the room for attendees to fill in contact information (see attached).
- 4. LK discussed the schedule for bidding and anticipated construction.
- 5. LK stated that Paulding County Hospital is tax exempt.
- 6. LK discussed that the "main hospital building" is the base bid and that the individual "out buildings" on the hospital campus are the alternates as listed in the plans and specs.
- 7. LK discussed the unit costs required with the bid are for potential replacement of compromised roof deck/sheathing as listed in the specs.
- 8. LK stated that bidders must include written acknowledgement for receipt of all addenda, included with their bid.
- 9. LK discussed the Summary of Work as outlined in the agenda.
- 10. LK opened the meeting for questions. The following questions from potential bidders were received along with the following discussion:
  - o What are the times for daily work?
    - 6 am is the earliest acceptable start time in general.
    - 8 am is the earliest acceptable start time above/around "med floor."
    - 8 pm is the latest time for daily completion of work.
  - Regarding the unit costs and pending field verification during demolition, there likely exists both insulated nail base deck and corrugated metal "B" deck. How should the cost for the potential need to repair and/or replace these items be handled with the owner?
    - As quickly as possible upon discovery of damaged/compromised construction that is determined to be beyond the scope of the unit costs as outlined, the contractor shall coordinate and conduct a meeting on-site with the owner and architect to review the damage and discuss solution options and costs.
    - Solution option(s) selected for repair/replacement of the damaged/compromised construction, as well as the respective unit cost(s), shall be clearly defined and agreed upon in writing by the contractor, architect, and owner, prior to proceeding with the work.
  - Is the warranty for the specified GAF shingle system intended to be the same as that specified for the Owens-Corning shingle system?
    - Yes, the Owens-Corning system, including the warranty, is the basis for the design and shall be equivalent if GAF system is chosen.
  - o Is there a hard and fast completion date for the project?
    - No. However, completion of the project is expected before cold weather sets in for the season.
  - Are hot-dipped galvanized nails acceptable for use on the project?
    - No, fasteners are to be selected from the options outlined in the specifications.





- The drawings indicate both "Open" (metal-lined) and "Closed-Cut" valleys. Is this correct or is one or the other preferred?
  - BA stated that "Open" metal-lined valleys are intended. BA agreed to review the drawings for errors or inconsistencies and issue a clarification/correction via
- New flashings are indicated for existing roof curbs. How are flashing of flanged curbs to be handled?
  - BA stated that new flashings are called out for but agreed that a clarification would be helpful and will be issued via addendum.
- Will the contract be awarded based primarily on the low bid of the base bid portion of the work?
  - Yes, the lowest base bid will be the primary bid consideration. However, the combined bid of accepted alternates will certainly influence the final award
- LK discussed the bond requirements.
- Project is not prevailing wage.

Aaron Eddy gave a guided tour of the roof work areas to interested attendees (Lucas Konger and Brian Andrews did not attend the guided tour with the bidders). Any additional site visits by bidding contractors will need to be scheduled with Aaron Eddy, 419-399-4080.

No further discussion took place, and the meeting adjourned. Please address any corrections or additions to these meeting notes to our office as soon as possible; otherwise these meeting notes, as written, will become a part of the project file.


