#### PART 1 - GENERAL CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. Pre-Bid Questions & Clarifications:
  - a. **Question:** The chiller (outside) is fed from the MCD in the North Mechanical Room. Can this feeder be ran underground along the West side of the building or does in need to run inside the building?
    - i. **Answer:** The chiller is to be fed as outlined in the bid documents.
  - b. **Question:** The Specs call for rigid conduit in the mechanical rooms. The existing building has EMT with rigid coming through the floor in most places. Can we use EMT conduit in the mechanical rooms and ceiling space?
    - i. <u>Answer:</u> Please follow the project specifications. You may provide a voluntary deduct alternate for EMT. Please clearly note where the substitution is occurring.
  - c. **Question:** Can you clarify the scope of work relative to note #10 on Site Demolition Plan (sheet C2.1)? Is that just like a 4" layer of stone for a walking path during construction?
    - i. <u>Answer:</u> The contractor is responsible to follow all applicable building codes, including the accessibility codes (2009 ICC A-117.1) for accessible pathways. Chapter 3 of the code defines various characteristics of an accessible path including changes in level, width of path, slope, etc. If possible, maintain the existing egress route (concrete sidewalk) until construction sequencing requires removal. If gravel is used as a pathway material, the pathway must comply with the definition of an accessible path from the egress door to the public right of way.
  - d. **Question:** Sheet A-321's details A3 and A4 call for "acoustical block" on the exterior screen walls with rockwool insulation. Is this an actual sound block like what is listed in the specifications 042000 2.4 D with vertical openings in the block for sound or is it just a regular block with a piece of rockwool stuffed in the cores? Does the trash enclosure require this as detailed on A3 sheet A-321?
    - i. <u>Answer:</u> The Trash Enclosure (A3/A-321) is to be standard CMU. The Chiller Enclosure (A4 and A6, sheet A-321) is to be acoustical CMU as outlined in specification section 042000, 2.4, D.
  - e. Question: Do you know when they anticipate starting this Goshen Library project?
    - Answer: The Library (Owner) would like to complete this project as soon as possible. The
      Library has requested short durations (3 weeks maximum) for building down-time or limited
      access because this is a public building and the building operations are critical to the public.
      The Contractor is required to follow the project specifications, including Section 002213
      Supplementary Instructions to Bidders, which outlines expectations for project start up
      including project schedule, schedule of subcontractors, etc.
