NOTE: Bidders are responsible for becoming familiar with every item of this Addendum. (This includes miscellaneous items at the very end of this Addendum.)

RE: ALL BIDDERS

ITEM NO. 1. PROJECT MANUAL, SECTION 00 41 16 - BID FORM

A. The Bid Form has been revised for this Project. This revised form, dated 1/20/25, is the applicable form to be used by all bidders and is included with and hereby made a part of this Addendum. Revision includes the creation of three Base Bids.

These revisions will be reflected on the Bid Forms provided for the convenience of the bidders.

ITEM NO. 2. PROJECT MANUAL, SECTION 01 10 00 - SUMMARY

- A. Replace 1.3, B., as follows:
 - "B. Type of Contract:
 - 1. Three single lump sum bids have been identified on the Bid Form for all work within the bidding documents with the inclusion of a specific Synthetic Grass Surfacing Manufacturer.
 - a. The specific single lump sum bid (No. 1, 2, or 3) Contract shall include all work within the bidding documents and Project Manual.
 - b. Bid proposals shall include additional information regarding the Synthetic Grass Surfacing as outlined in Section 32 18 13.

ITEM NO. 3. PROJECT MANUAL, SECTION 32 18 13 - SYNTHETIC GRASS SURFACING

- A. Replace 1.4, A., as follows:
 - "A. Bid Period Submittals: All manufacturer's for the baseball and softball systems shall submit the following specific information about the products included in the bid proposals with the bids. These items shall be included within the bid proposal envelope."

Note: Subparagraphs 1., through 4., as written are still applicable to 1.4, A.

- B. Replace 1.8, A., as follows:
 - "A. Turf Manufacturer's Standard Warranty: Manufacturer shall warrant synthetic grass surfacing against defects in the material provided, including ultraviolet degradation, excessive fading, wrinkling, panel movement, shock absorbency, etc.
 - 1. The warranty should have the following provisions:
 - a. Warranty Period: Minimum of eight (8) years from the date of Substantial Completion.

- b. Warranty shall include materials and workmanship.
- c. Must have provisions to repair or replace such portions of installed materials that are no longer serviceable to maintain a serviceable and playable surface.
- d. Warrant that the yarn used to make the grass-like tufts will maintain its UV stability and tensile strength such that the strength of the fiber when measured in accordance with ASTM D-2256 will not decrease by more than 50% during the warranty period due to breakdown of UV stability.
- 2. Submit copy of Manufacturer's standard warranty form with bid proposal.


