This Addendum is issued in accordance with the provisions of "The General Conditions of the Contract for Construction," Article 1, "Contract Documents" and becomes a part of the Contract Documents as provided therein. This Addendum includes:

PART 4 – QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

- 1. Q: Can we email bid responses or must they be mailed?
 - A: During the Pre-Bid Meeting, Context indicated email responses would be satisfactory. <u>However, that is not in alignment with the published Notice to Bidders.</u>
 Respondents must mail or hand-deliver sealed envelopes to the address identified within the public notice. Emailed responses are insufficient.
- 2. Q: Can you clarify the warranty requirements for PT Concrete?
 - A: The 'Bid Form' has been revised to more clearly delineate warranty options. The baseline project shall have a two (2) year warranty. Additional enhanced warranties are now articulated within the Bid Form.
- 3. Q: Are you wanting multiple primes or a single prime contractor?
 - A: SACS desires a single prime contractor, as stated in the Notice to Bidders.
- 4. Q: What date will we be able to mobilize demolition?
 - A: SACS has confirmed that May 13, 2025 is the date of full access. Upon mutual agreement of SACS and the builder, it may be possible to stage equipment and materials in advance of that date, as well as incidental improvements that would not affect use of the track.

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- 5. **Q: Should we plan to poly-coat Pole Vault, Long Jump, and High Jump?**A: Respondents shall coat the Pole Vault pit, Pole Vault runway, and Long Jump runway in 'blue' to match the primary track design. The High Jump area shall be coated in 'charcoal' to match the primary track design.
- 6. **Q: Should the Track Allowance be added to every track response?**A: Yes, whether you are responding to an asphalt or concrete solution, all Base Bid responses for track shall include the Allowance. Turf pricing can exclude the allowance.
- 7. **Q: Drawing C100 (Note 3) indicates conflicting information about demolition of nailer curbs. What is the intent?**A: Great question. For the Asphalt track response, the existing concrete nailer would be protected and the nailer board itself replaced. For a PT Concrete track response, the existing nailer curb is removed in its entirety and a nailer board added inside the PT edge.
