The following items are a revision/clarification to the requirements of the Bidding Documents for this Project. The articles contained in this Addendum take precedence over the requirements of the previously published Bidding Documents. Where any article of the Specifications or any detail of the Drawings is modified or deleted by the article contained in the Addendum, the unaltered provisions of that article paragraph, subparagraph, or clause shall remain in effect.

The Bidder must acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by acknowledgement on the Proposal Form. Failure to do so can be cause for bid rejection.

Item No. 1: **Revision – Proposal Form (8” Gate Valve)**

The Proposal Form has been revised to add the 8” Gate Valve shown on Sheet 8 (STA 10+08) to the Base Bid (see attached revised Proposal Form). A new Line Item 4 has been added to the Base Bid to account for the 8” Gate Valve. As a result, the quantity for Mandatory Alternate MA-2 has been reduced to one (1) 8” Gate Valve. If the Mandatory Alternate is not accepted, a cap shall be installed after this gate valve to terminate for future extension.

Item No. 2: **Revision – Proposal Form (Added Pay Item “Crop Damage Allowance”)**

The Proposal Form has been revised to include a Crop Damage Allowance in the amount of \$5,000 (Line Item 13). Costs incurred by the Contractor for crop damage within the limits of the permanent and temporary easements required for construction shall be eligible for reimbursement under this allowance. Additional requirements and procedures governing the use of this allowance are noted below in the measurement and payment provisions.

- The lump sum price specified is designated as an allowance to be included in the total bid price for compensation of crop damage occurring within the permanent and temporary easements for the Project. This allowance shall include costs associated with crop damage resulting from construction activities within the limits of the existing easements.
- The Contractor shall coordinate with the affected property owner or tenant to document crop damage within the easements prior to requesting payment from this allowance. Contractor shall submit written documentation identifying the location and extent of the crop damage, along with any supporting information or agreements, for approval. Contractor may request reimbursement following payment to the affected

property owner or tenant and submission of documentation verifying the actual compensation paid.

- Crop damage occurring outside the limits of the acquired permanent or temporary easements shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor. Compensation for such damages shall be paid by the Contractor at no additional cost to the Owner and shall not be reimbursed under this allowance.

Item No. 3: **Information** – Indiana Bat Tree Clearing Rule

This project does not include a federal funding or permitting component; therefore, tree clearing restrictions related to the Indiana Bat are not included in the Bidding Documents.

Item No. 4: **Clarification** – Plan Sheet 3, General Note #1

Contractor shall clear trees, brush, and stumps within the entire easement width along the proposed utility alignment. Clearing shall not be limited to that necessary for construction access.

All clearing debris, including wood chips, shall be removed from the project site and disposed of properly.

Item No. 5: **Clarification** – Plan Sheet 3, General Note #4

The intent is for an erosion control blanket (ECB) to be installed in areas where necessary to ensure successful vegetation/stabilization. If vegetation can be successfully established with straw mulch, then ECB is not required. ECB is expected in swales and on steeper slopes (i.e. 3H:1V) where straw mulch alone is unlikely to remain in place.

Item No. 6: **Clarification** – Plan Sheet 10, Existing Force Main Connection

The existing force main is not active. It was installed across I-69 as part of a previous project. This project extends that force main, with a future lift station to be constructed by others.

Item No. 7: **Revision** – Locating Post

Contractor shall furnish and install one (1) 6-foot galvanized steel T-post adjacent to each air relief valve structure for future locating purposes.

- Final Completion: 120 consecutive days

BIDDER further agrees to pay as liquidated damages, the sum of \$1,000.00 for each consecutive calendar day thereafter for all of the required completion times as provided in Article 17 of the Supplementary General Conditions.

BIDDER Acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

All bid items below shall include equipment manufactures as specified in the Drawings, Specifications, or Addenda. No alternate manufacturers shall be approved as equal by the ENGINEER or OWNER until after the bid date and only if listed on the voluntary deduct page of the Proposal Form.

The bid award shall be made in the best interests of the OWNER utilizing any combination of the Base Bid amounts and Mandatory Bid Alternates if applicable. BIDDER agrees to perform all the Work described in the Bidding Documents for the following unit price or lump sum amounts (all Work indicated in the Drawings and Specifications shall be performed and shall be included in the most applicable bid item).
